

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are four sizes of hook type fork carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for loads up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for cargo up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted blades vary by the amount of offset between the tine and the tine eye. Various manufacturers would differ the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
